### Open Call for “Associated Regions”

In the context of the [RHE-MEDIation project](#) (Grant agreement ID: 101113045), an **Open Call for Associated Regions (OC4ARs) will be launched on March 31, 2025**. The RHE-MEDIation project aims to develop micro-algae-based innovative technologies for water remediation from chemical pollution and water quality monitoring. Within WP5 (Development of replication activities and solution implementation roadmap) of the project, the OC4ARs is open to Third Parties of the Associated Regions that will apply to the open call by proposing a replication site, with similar characteristics to the ones included in the RHE-MEDIation project, where assessing the replicability potential of the RHE-MEDIation technologies. The five selected replication sites will be provided with a **grant financial support scheme and receive up to 100.000€ per site**, thus complementing the exploitation and replication activity of the RHE-MEDIation technologies by sharing knowledge to maximise future implementation opportunities.

**Eligible beneficiaries** for this call are local and/or regional organizations (public entities) established in an **EU Member State, EU Overseas Countries and Territories or Associated Countries**. Applicants cannot be based in any of the countries of the RHE-MEDIation Consortium (Italy, Greece, Portugal, Belgium, Turkey).
